WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

Who is the Holy Spirit? So far we have discovered:

- **He is God.** He is with us now. He is working on our behalf.
- **He is a Person.** He relates to us, responds to us, and wants a relationship with us.
- **He is our Guide.** He leads us to truth, right thoughts, and transforms our lives.

John 7:37 On the last day, the climax of the festival, Jesus stood and shouted to the crowds, "Anyone who is thirsty may come to me! **38** Anyone who believes in me may come and drink! For the Scriptures declare, 'Rivers of living water will flow from his heart.'" **39** (When he said "living water," he was speaking of the Spirit, who would be given to everyone believing in him. But the Spirit had not yet been given, because Jesus had not yet entered into his glory.) (NLT)

Isaiah 58:11 The Lord will guide you continually, And satisfy your soul in drought, And strengthen your bones; You shall be like a watered garden, And like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. (NKJV)

A Law of Biblical Interpretation:

Genesis 2:10 Now a river flowed out of Eden to water the garden; and from there it divided and became four rivers. **11** The name of the first is Pishon; it flows around the whole land of Havilah, where there is gold. **12** The gold of that land is good; the bdellium and the onyx stone are there as well. **13** The name of the second river is Gihon; it flows around the whole land of Cush. **14** The name of the third river is Tigris; it flows east of Assyria. And the fourth river is the Euphrates. (NLT)

Tigris (Hebrew - Hiddekel): כַּדְדֵּקֶל (khid-deh'-kel) - vehement, rapid, great (miraculous) power

1 Peter 5:8 Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. (NLT)

Gihon: גִּיחֹן (ghee-khone') - labor; bring forth; burst forth; fight to get something revealed.

1 Timothy 1:18 Timothy, my son, here are my instructions for you, based on the prophetic words spoken about you earlier. May they help you fight well in the Lord's battles. **19** Cling to your faith in Christ, and keep your conscience clear. For some people have deliberately violated their consciences; as a result, their faith has been shipwrecked. (NLT)

1 Timothy 6:12 Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and for which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. *(NASB)*

1 Corinthians 2:9 That is what the Scriptures mean when they say, "No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love him."

10 But it was to us that God revealed these things by his Spirit. For his Spirit searches out everything and shows us God's deep secrets. **11** No one can know a person's thoughts except that person's own spirit, and no one can know God's thoughts except God's own Spirit. **12** And we have received God's Spirit (not the world's spirit), so we can know the wonderful things God has freely given us. *(NLT)*

Genesis 45:1 Then Joseph could not control himself in front of everyone standing before him, and he shouted, "Have everyone leave me!" So there was no one with him when Joseph made himself known to his brothers. **2** Then he wept so loudly that the Egyptians heard it, and the household of Pharaoh heard about it. **3** And Joseph said to his brothers, "I am Joseph! Is my father still alive?" But his brothers could not answer him, for they were terrified in his presence. *(NLT)*

2 Corinthians 2:7 Yet when I am among mature believers, I do speak with words of wisdom, but not the kind of wisdom that belongs to this world or to the rulers of this world, who are soon forgotten. **7** No, the wisdom we speak of is the mystery of God—his plan that was previously hidden, even though he made it for our ultimate glory before the world began. **8** But the rulers of this world have not understood it; if they had, they would not have crucified our glorious Lord. *(NLT)*

Revelation #2

John 14:26 "But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you." *(NLT)*

John 16:13 "When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future. **14** He will bring me glory by telling you whatever he receives from me. **15** All that belongs to the Father is mine; this is why I said, 'The Spirit will tell you whatever he receives from me.'" *(NLT)*

Matthew 16:14 "Well," they replied, "some say John the Baptist, some say Elijah, and others say Jeremiah or one of the other prophets." **15** Then he asked them, "But who do you say I am?" **16** Simon Peter answered, "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." **17** Jesus replied, "You are blessed, Simon son of John, because my Father in heaven has revealed this to you. You did not learn this from any human being." (NLT)

Spirit (_____): Imago Dei) - Spiritual (God-consciousness)

- Greek: πνεῦμα pneuma (pnyoo'-mah): The spirit (Spirit), wind, or breath
- Relates to: God / Spiritual
- Gates of learning: Holy Spirit; Spiritual Insight, Meaning, Purpose, Intuition

Soul (_____) - Psychological (self-consciousness)

- Greek: ψυχή psuché (psoo-khay'): Direct aftermath of God breathing (blowing) His gift of life into a person, making them an ensouled being. (psyche)
- Relates to: Others / Natural
- Gates of learning: Imagination, Conscious Mind (thinking, reasoning, love), Memory, Will (choices), Sub-Conscious Mind (beliefs, attitudes, feelings, emotions), Affections

Body (_____) - Physiological (world-consciousness)

- Greek: σῶμα sóma (so'-mah): The physical body; Used figuratively of the Body of Christ.
- Relates to: Environment / Carnal
- Gates of learning: 5 Senses (sight, smell, hearing, taste, touch); Nerves / Brain / Organs / Cells

Revelation #4

GOD'S _____

Ephesians 1:16 I have not stopped thanking God for you. I pray for you constantly, **17** asking God, the glorious Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, to give you spiritual wisdom and insight so that you might grow in your knowledge of God. **18** I pray that your hearts will be flooded with light so that you can understand the confident hope he has given to those he called—his holy people who are his rich and glorious inheritance. (NLT)

Jeremiah 33:3 'Call to Me and I will answer you, and I will tell you great and mighty* things, which you do not know.' (NASB)
*(incomprehensible)

Jeremiah 33:3 'Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty* things, which you do not know.' (NKJV)
*(inaccessible)

Jeremiah 33:3 'Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.' (NIV)

Matthew 7:7 Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. **8** For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. (NASB)

Matthew 7:7 "Keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. **8** For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened. (NLT)

Jeremiah 33:3 Ask me and I will tell you remarkable secrets you do not know about things to come. (NLT)

Romans 8:26 And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. (NLT)

1 Corinthians 14:2 For if you have the ability to speak in tongues* (or unknown languages), you will be talking only to God, since people won't be able to understand you. You will be speaking by the power of the Spirit* (speaking in your spirit), but it will all be mysterious. (NLT)
