- Who is worthy? No one...
 - No one can unlock the scrolls.
 - No one can unlock the future.
 - No one can look ahead and see what is coming.
 - Only Jesus can unlock the scroll.
 - We are called to faithfulness, not to figure out or unlock the future.

Revelation 5:11 Then I looked, and I heard the voices of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders; and the number of them was myriads of myriads, and thousands of thousands, **12** saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slaughtered to receive power, wealth, wisdom, might, honor, glory, and blessing." **13** And I heard every created thing which is in heaven, or on the earth, or under the earth, or on the sea, and all the things in them, saying, "To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be the blessing, the honor, the glory, and the dominion forever and ever." **14** And the four living creatures were saying, "Amen." And the elders fell down and worshiped. (NASB)

Revelation 5:4 Then I began to weep bitterly because no one was found worthy to open the scroll and read it. (NLT)

Revelation 5:5 And one of the elders *said to me, "Stop weeping; behold, the Lion that is from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome so as to be able to open the scroll and its seven seals." (NASB)

Revelation 5:5 But one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals." (NKJ)

Revelation 5:5 But one of the twenty-four elders said to me, "Stop weeping! Look, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the heir to David's throne, has won the victory. He is worthy to open the scroll and its seven seals." (NLT)

 - Remember Christ's title's are now Jewish
- Kinsmen Redeemer

Genesis 49:9 Judah is a lion's cub; From the prey, my son, you have gone up. He crouches, he lies down as a lion, And as a lion, who dares to stir him up? **10** The scepter will not depart from Judah, Nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes, And to him shall be the obedience of the peoples. (NASB)

Isaiah 11:1 Then a shoot will spring from the stem of Jesse, And a Branch from his roots will bear fruit. **2** The Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him, The spirit of wisdom and understanding, The spirit of counsel and strength, The spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord. (NASB)

Revelation 5:6 Then I saw a Lamb that looked as if it had been slaughtered, but it was now standing between the throne and the four living beings and among the twenty-four elders. He had seven horns and seven eyes, which represent the sevenfold Spirit of God that is sent out into every part of the earth. (NLT)

Worship Is _____ And _____.

- Lamb that was slaughtered.
 - Passover lamb; the best lamb, specifically chosen
 - Taken special care for 4 days, then slaughtered
- Arnion (Greek); ἀρνίον (ar-nee'-on)
 - A little lamb; young lamb
 - Only used 30 times in New Testament
 - John 21:15 ("Feed my Lambs"); Revelation

Worship Is _____ And _____ By The Holy Spirit.

- Horns are a symbol of power.
- Proper response to God
 - Spirit-led
 - Spirit-powered
 - Spirit-directed
 - Spirit-protected

Revelation 5:7 He stepped forward and took the scroll from the right hand of the one sitting on the throne. **8** And when he took the scroll, the four living beings and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb. Each one had a harp, and they held gold bowls filled with incense, which are the prayers of God's people. (NLT)

Worship Of God Cannot Be _____ From The _____ Of God.

- Jesus submits to the Authority of God the Father.
 - Right to open the scroll, but doesn't take it on His own.
 - You cannot be led by the Spirit to rebel against authority.
 - You cannot say in our worship "we can't help ourselves."
- Lambanó (Greek); λαμβάνω (lam-ban'-o)
 - Actively lay hold of; take or receive
 - Aggressively (confidently) lay hold of; take or receive

Matthew 7:8 For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. (NASB)

Matthew 8:17 This happened so that what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet would be fulfilled: "He Himself took our illnesses and carried away our diseases." (NASB)

Matthew 10:38 And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. (NASB)

According to Vincent's Word Studies, The whole multitude withdrew from the inner court and fell down before the Lord, spreading their hands in silent prayer. Deep silence rested on the worshiping multitude, while within the sanctuary itself the priest laid the incense on the golden altar, the cloud of odors rose up before the Lord.
