Mark 2:6 But some of the teachers of religious law who were sitting there thought to themselves, **7** "What is he saying? This is blasphemy! Only God can forgive sins!" **8** Jesus knew immediately what they were thinking, so he asked them, "Why do you question this in your hearts? **9** Is it easier to say to the paralyzed man 'Your sins are forgiven,' or 'Stand up, pick up your mat, and walk'?
