1 Peter 5:7a Give all your worries and cares to God... (NLT)

1 Peter 5:7a Cast all your anxiety on him... (NASB)

Care: (English - noun [kair]); a state of mind in which one is troubled; worry, anxiety, or concern; a cause or object of worry, anxiety, concern, etc.

Care: μέριμνα; (Greek - merimna [mer'-im-nah]); care, worry, anxiety; a part, separated from the whole; worry (anxiety), dividing and fracturing a person's being into parts.

The Verb

1 Peter 5:7b ... for He cares for you.... (NKJV)

1 Peter 5:7b ... for he cares about you. (NLT)

1 Peter 5:7b ... because he cares for you. (NASB)

Care: (English - verb [kair]); to be concerned or solicitous; have thought or regard.

Care: μέλει; (Greek - meló [mel'-o]); to be an object of care; "to care, be concerned" – to care about (be concerned with), especially paying attention (giving thought) to – i.e. "taking an interest"

Matthew 20:29 As Jesus and his disciples were leaving Jericho, a large crowd followed him. **30** Two blind men were sitting by the roadside, and when they heard that Jesus was going by, they shouted, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us!" (NASB)

Matthew 20:31 The crowd rebuked them and told them to be quiet, but they shouted all the louder, "Lord, Son of David, have mercy on us!" (NASB)

Compassion: (English - noun [kuhm-pash-uhn]); a feeling of deep sympathy and sorrow for another who is stricken by misfortune, accompanied by a strong desire to alleviate the suffering.

Matthew 20:32 Jesus stopped and called them. “What do you want me to do for you?” he asked. (NASB)

Matthew 20:25 But Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers in this world lord it over their people, and officials flaunt their authority over those under them. **26** But among you it will be different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, **27** and whoever wants to be first among you must become your slave. **28** For even the Son of

Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.” (NLT)

Compassion Comes From _____

Matthew 20:33 “Lord,” they answered, “we want our sight.” **34** Jesus had compassion on them and touched their eyes. Immediately they received their sight and followed him. (NASB)

Compassion: σπλαγχνίζομαι; (Greek - splanchnizomai [splangkhnid'-zom-ahee]); “Moved to compassion;” to be moved in the inward parts, to feel compassion, to be moved in the inward parts (seat of the affections) to feel compassion.

Matthew 9:36 When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them because they were confused and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. (NLT)

Compassion Seeks To _____ The

1 John 3:17 If someone has enough money to live well and sees a brother or sister in need but shows no compassion—how can God’s love be in that person? *(NLT)*

Matthew 25:34 “Then the King will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father, inherit the Kingdom prepared for you from the creation of the world. **35** For I was hungry, and you fed me. I was thirsty, and you gave me a drink. I was a stranger, and you invited me into your home. **36** I was naked, and you gave me clothing. I was sick, and you cared for me. I was in prison, and you visited me.’ **37** “Then these righteous ones will reply, ‘Lord, when did we ever see you hungry and feed you? Or thirsty and give you something to drink? **38** Or a stranger and show you hospitality? Or naked and give you clothing? **39** When did we ever see you sick or in prison and visit you?’ **40** “And the King will say, ‘I tell you the truth, when you did it to one of the least of these my brothers and sisters, you were doing it to me!’ *(NLT)*
