## HEROES: ELISHA

**2 Kings 4:38** Elisha now returned to Gilgal, and there was a famine in the land. One day as the group of prophets was seated before him, he said to his servant, "Put a large pot on the fire, and make some stew for the rest of the group." **39** One of the young men went out into the field to gather herbs and came back with a pocketful of wild gourds. He shredded them and put them into the pot without realizing they were poisonous. **40** Some of the stew was served to the men. But after they had eaten a bite or two they cried out, "Man of God, there's poison in this stew!" So they would not eat it. **41** Elisha said, "Bring me some flour." Then he threw it into the pot and said, "Now it's all right; go ahead and eat." And then it did not harm them. (NLT)

**Psalms 30:11** You have turned my mourning into joyful dancing. You have taken away my clothes of mourning and clothed me with joy, **12** that I might sing praises to you and not be silent. O Lord my God, I will give you thanks forever! (NLT)

**2 Kings 4:42** One day a man from Baal-shalishah brought the man of God a sack of fresh grain and twenty loaves of barley bread made from the first grain of his harvest. Elisha said, "Give it to the people so they can eat." **43** "What?" his servant exclaimed. "Feed a hundred people with only this?" But Elisha repeated, "Give it to the people so they can eat, for this is what the Lord says: Everyone will eat, and there will even be some left over!" **44** And when they gave it to the people, there was plenty for all and some left over, just as the Lord had promised. *(NLT)*
