Matthew 5:3 "God blesses those who are poor and realize their need for him, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs. **4** God blesses those who mourn, for they will be comforted. **5** God blesses those who are humble, for they will inherit the whole earth. **6** God blesses those who hunger and thirst for justice, for they will be satisfied. **7** God blesses those who are merciful, for they will be shown mercy. **8** God blesses those whose hearts are pure, for they will see God. **9** God blesses those who work for peace, for they will be called the children of God. **10** God blesses those who are persecuted for doing right, for the Kingdom of Heaven is theirs. **11** "God blesses you when people mock you and persecute you and lie about you and say all sorts of evil things against you because you are my followers. Poor In Spirit:

- Recognize your utter spiritual bankruptcy before God. I have nothing of worth to give to God. Sin has made me spiritually destitute.

Mourn:

- Those who recognize their sinful ways and acknowledge their need for God. The Spirit comforts those who are honest about their own sin and humble enough to ask for forgiveness and healing.

Humble:

- Strength under control. Having the power or ability and not using it for another's benefit. Gentle not pushy or showy.

Hunger / Thirst for Justice:

- Spiritual longing for God to do what is right. Give eternal life (Salvation from sin). Give eternal justice (Salvation in eternity).

Merciful

- Compassionate to those in need. Forgiving. Kind. Undeserved.

Pure Hearts:

- Singleness of heart toward God. A pure heart has no hypocrisy, no guile, no hidden ulterior motives. The pure heart is marked by transparency and an uncompromising desire to please God in all things.

Work For Peace:

- There is no peace without knowing God. The Message of the Gospel IS peace. Those who share the Gospel are the peacemakers.

Persecuted:

- Uncompromising faithfulness to God despite every threat and pressure. Staying faithful to the Word of God (doing what is right) when pressured with abuse (verbal or physical).

Philippians 1:27 Above all, you must live as citizens of heaven, conducting yourselves in a manner worthy of the Good News about Christ. Then, whether I come and see you again or only hear about you, I will know that you are standing together with one spirit and one purpose, fighting together for the faith, which is the Good News. **28** Don't be intimidated in any way by your enemies. This will be a sign to them that they are going to be destroyed, but that you are going to be saved, even by God himself. **29** For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but also the privilege of suffering for him. **30** We are in this struggle together. You have seen my struggle in the past, and you know that I am still in the midst of it. (NLT)

He left his case in the hands of God, who always judges fairly. **24** He personally carried

our sins in his body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By his wounds you are healed. **25** Once you were like sheep who wandered away. But now you have turned to your Shepherd, the Guardian of your souls. *(NLT)*
