### Question #1

**John 12:1** Six days before the Passover celebration began, Jesus arrived in Bethany, the home of Lazarus—the man he had raised from the dead. **2** A dinner was prepared in Jesus' honor. Martha served, and Lazarus was among those who ate with him. **3** Then Mary took a twelve-ounce jar of expensive perfume made from essence of nard, and she anointed Jesus' feet with it, wiping his feet with her hair. The house was filled with the fragrance. (NLT)

**John 12:12** The next day, the news that Jesus was on the way to Jerusalem swept through the city. A large crowd of Passover visitors **13** took palm branches and went down the road to meet him. They shouted, "Praise God! Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord! Hail to the King of Israel!" (NLT)

**John 14:15** "If you love me, obey my commandments. **16** And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate, who will never leave you. **17** He is the Holy Spirit, who leads into all truth. The world cannot receive him, because it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you know him, because he lives with you now and later will be in you. But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you...**27** "I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid. **28** Remember what I told you: I am going away, but I will come back to you again. If you really loved me, you would be happy that I am going to the Father, who is greater than I am. **29** I have told you these things before they happen so that when they do happen, you will believe." (NLT)

**John 15:18** "If the world hates you, remember that it hated me first. **19** The world would love you as one of its own if you belonged to it, but you are no longer part of the world. I chose you to come out of the world, so it hates you. **20** Do you remember what I told you? 'A slave is not greater than the master.' Since they persecuted me, naturally they will persecute you. And if they had listened to me, they would listen to you. **21** They will do all this to you because of me, for they have rejected the one who sent me. **22** They would not be guilty if I had not come and spoken to them. But now they have no excuse

for their sin. **23** Anyone who hates me also hates my Father. **24** If I hadn't done such miraculous signs among them that no one else could do, they would not be guilty. But as it is, they have seen everything I did, yet they still hate me and my Father.

**25** This fulfills what is written in their Scriptures: 'They hated me without cause.' **26** "But I will send you the Advocate—the Spirit of truth. He will come to you from the Father and will testify all about me. **27** And you must also testify about me because you have been with me from the beginning of my ministry." (NLT)

**John 16:5** "But now I am going away to the one who sent me, and not one of you is asking where I am going. **6** Instead, you grieve because of what I've told you. **7** But in fact, it is best for you that I go away, because if I don't, the Advocate won't come. If I do go away, then I will send him to you. **8** And when he comes, he will convict the world of its sin, and of God's righteousness, and of the coming judgment. **9** The world's sin is that it refuses to believe in me. **10** Righteousness is available because I go to the Father, and you will see me no more." (NLT)

**Matthew 28:18** Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. **19** Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. **20** Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." (NLT)

**2 Corinthians 1:21** Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and anointed us is God, **22** who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge. (NASB)

**1 John 2:27** And as for you, the anointing which you received from Him remains in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you remain in Him. (NASB)

**2 Peter 1:3** By his divine power, God has given us everything we need for living a godly life. We have received all of this by coming to know him, the one who called us to himself by means of his marvelous glory and excellence. (NLT)

**Exodus 30:26** Use this sacred oil to anoint the Tabernacle, the Ark of the Covenant, **27** the table and all its utensils, the lampstand and all its accessories, the incense altar, **28** the altar of burnt offering and all its utensils, and the washbasin with its stand. **29** Consecrate them to make them absolutely holy. After this, whatever touches them will also become holy. (NLT)

**James 5:13** Are any of you suffering hardships? You should pray. Are any of you happy? You should sing praises. **14** Are any of you sick? You should call for the elders of the church to come and pray over you, anointing you with oil in the name of the Lord. **15** Such a prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make you well. And if you have committed any sins, you will be forgiven.

**16** Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results. (NLT)

**Psalm 23:5** You prepare a feast for me in the presence of my enemies. You honor me by anointing my head with oil. My cup overflows with blessings. (NLT)
