**Exodus 33:13** Now then, if I have found favor in Your sight in any way, please let me know Your ways so that I may know You, in order that I may find favor in Your sight. Consider too, that this nation is Your people." **14** And He said, "My presence shall go with you, and I will give you rest."

**What's the real question?**

**15** Then he said to Him, "If Your presence does not go with us, do not lead us up from here. **16** For how then can it be known that I have found favor in Your sight, I and Your people? Is it not by Your going with us, so that we, I and Your people, may be distinguished from all the other people who are on the face of the earth?" **17** The Lord said to Moses, "I will also do this thing of which you have spoken; for you have found favor in My sight and I have known you by name."

**Let Me Explain...**

**18** Then Moses said, "Please, show me Your glory!" **19** And He said, "I Myself will make all My goodness pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the Lord before you; and I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show compassion to whom I will show compassion." **20** He further said, "You cannot see My face, for mankind shall not see Me and live!" (NASB)

**Let Me Sum Up...**

**Isaiah 6:1** In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple. **2** Seraphim were standing above Him, each having six wings: with two each covered his face, and with two each covered his feet, and with two each flew. **3** And one called out to another and said, "Holy, Holy, Holy, is the Lord of armies. The whole earth [fullness of the whole earth is His glory] is full of His glory." (NLT)

**Luke 1:26-38** In the sixth month of Elizabeth's pregnancy, God sent the angel Gabriel to Nazareth, a village in Galilee, **27** to a virgin named Mary. She was engaged to be married to a man named Joseph, a descendant of King David. **28** Gabriel appeared to her and said, "Greetings, [Rejoice] favored woman! The Lord is with you! [Blessed are you among women.]" **29** Confused and disturbed, Mary tried to think what the angel could mean. **30** "Don't be afraid, Mary," the angel told her, "for you have found favor with God! **31** You will conceive and give birth to a son, and you will name him Jesus. **32** He will be very great and will be called the Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David. **33** And he will reign over Israel forever; his Kingdom will never end!" **34** Mary asked the angel, "But how can this happen? I am a virgin." **35** The angel replied, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the baby to be born will be holy, and he will be called the Son of God. **36** What's more, your relative Elizabeth has become pregnant in her old age! People used to say she was barren, but she has conceived a son and is now in her sixth month. **37** For the word of God will never fail. [For nothing is impossible with God.]" **38** Mary responded, "I am the Lord's servant. May everything you have said about me come true." And then the angel left her. *(NLT)*
